About 15-20 members, after enjoying a half-hour of socializing on the patio and fresh grilled hamburgers, hot dogs and chili, filed into the clubhouse for this month's meeting. **Jeff Stempien** called the meeting to order at 7:17PM. Following the Pledge of Allegiance, the following subjects were discussed.

**Dewey**, filling in for absent Rich Thibodeau, gave a recap of the club's expenses and income for the previous month, and stated that the club continues to be in good financial shape. Members interested in learning details are encouraged to come to the next monthly meeting; financial figures are no longer being published in the minutes.

Dewey added that the May 4 work party that was rained out will be rescheduled. The range is good. 20-yard targets were rebuilt, chicken wire removed and now contain only foam. Next planned for this re-do are 60-yard targets.

**Joe Santora** said that because the Trad Shoot was delayed (new date is May 19), this month's Open Shoot will be canceled. The next Open Shoot will be in June.

**Jeff Sempien** said that the Bow Hunting Safety Class will be this Saturday (May 11) at the Club. About 30-35 people are expected to attend. Club membership is booming, he added. Concerning the upcoming Trad Shoot, we need to know who's going to be coming to help, for parking, cooking, etc., so if you're planning to come help, please notify Jeff without delay. Jeff commented that it may be necessary to limit the number of guests at next year's Trad Shoot. **Joe Santora** said that last year 113 people came and signed in.

**Jeff** said he wants to make additional parking available in the wet area beyond the shed; progress making the area usable is being made with stone fill and dams. A lot of firewood has been split from felled trees.

For the cooking area on the patio, **Jeff** managed to acquire a 6-foot commercial grill and 3 folding picnic benches. A new tarp will be purchased.

**Mike Ciccone** presented an award from Greg Richards of [details missing] to **Jeff**.

**John Mikolay** said we may be able to get free targets from commercial sponsors. **Mike Ciccone** said Encore Targets is going to send us some free 2-D targets.

**Jeff** displayed 3 styles of club baseball-type hats he ordered to have available for sale at the upcoming Trad Shoot and those present were offered a chance to buy them now at cost (\$15 each).
