Club Members' Meeting Minutes
July 10, 2019

Twelve members and one member's spouse attended this month's meeting. **Jeff Stempien** called the meeting to order at 7:06PM. Following the Pledge of Allegiance, the following subjects were discussed.

Dewey talked about the recent (July 6) work party; only 4 people (including Dewey) showed up. Most of the work involved weed whacking, but was cut short around noon by rain. The Club now owns two new weed whackers. The next work party may be at the end of this month; if not, then in September. Stay tuned.

Plans are to put out a new broadhead target and fix the 80-yard target.

Jeff announced there was a good turn out for the June 30 Open Shoot—over 35 paying guests showed up. A few guests bought Club hats as well. There was then talk about getting more bows for small kids. The Club's official minimum age to shoot is 10, but we allow younger kids to shoot if they can draw the bow. If they can't, they can't.

Dewey then reviewed the Club's finances for those present. As per past policy, figures will not be published in these minutes. Members wishing to know details are invited to attend the next meeting (August 8) or speak to the officers.

Jeff then brought up the subject of our Open Shoots. While this last Open Shoot was profitable, our problem is that not enough members show up to help. Help is not only needed to shepherd guests through the sign-in process but also to help with the cooking and cleanup. If we can't get enough volunteers to help next time, Jeff may decide to cancel the August Open Shoot.

There was also discussion about guests who overreach by taking extra bottles of water or soda or who eat a lot more food than normal. One suggestion

was to hand out voucher tickets redeemable for one hamburger, one hot dog and one drink to paying guests at Open Shoots. Nothing was decided however.

Then there was discussion about Open Shoot guests who stay after closing time. There's no obvious solution except perhaps to post a larger sign. Another complaint was people putting trash in the portable toilets. Not much can be done about that except posting more signs and making more trash bins available.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:37PM. The grill was fired up and freshly cooked hamburgers were enjoyed by all.
