Club Members' Meeting Minutes  
October 9, 2019

16 member including 6 new members attended this month's meeting. Jeff Stempien called the meeting to order at 7:10PM. Following the Pledge of Allegiance, the following subjects were discussed.

Dewey said that the 80-yard target was rebuilt. There are 2 work parties left this year, November 2 and December 7. New (associate) members don't have to come to work parties this year to fulfill their annual obligation. Separately, all persons weed-whacking or using a chain saw on club premises will be required to use face shields, available from the club. SAFETY practices are not a suggestion but mandatory while using power tools while on club grounds.

Joe reported that the September's Open Shoot (September 29) brought more than 65 paying guests. The weather was beautiful. For the first time, we ran out of food. A brief mention was again made about providing tickets for food, since some people were observed eating much more than their fair share. Also, we have to be aware that some families with kids are unfamiliar with archery or our equipment and need to be told, or reminded, of the basics. Joe cited one example, an arrow found embedded high up in a tree, shot by a youngster who was too far away from the target. It is important that everyone stays on the marked trails. In future open shoots, guests must come before 11:00AM and be off the course by 12:45PM. No children under 10 years old will be allowed.

Jeff then presented balance information at the Club's two bank accounts, described recently paid bills and talked about the property's tax assessment. As per past policy, figures will not be published in these minutes. Members wishing to know details are invited to attend the next meeting (November 13) or speak to the officers.

Jeff described how he was able to obtain a new \$2,500 8 x 12 shed for the club at a bargain price—basically, free, plus the cost of towing and a new roof, or only about \$600. Good going, Jeff!

There was some talk about getting gravel and fill; Bill Common volunteered to get some.

Six new members were welcomed at this meeting: Dave Elliot and Jane Sulich of Riverside; Jason Bealer of Stamford, Pete Williams of Cos Cob, Bill Hessert of Darien, and Scott Ackerman of Darien. Welcome aboard!

Reminder: All members are required to sign in when they arrive at the club. Guests of members are welcome. They must sign waivers and must be accompanied by a club member while on the course. The fee for guests to shoot is \$10 and is to be placed along with the waiver in the strong box on the left wall as you enter the club house.

There being no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned at 7:37PM.
